PACKAGE FOR MOISTURE AND RODENT CONTROL... \$30.00. CONSISTS OF 2 STARBRITE NO DAMP PACKAGES AND 2 PEST CONTROL BAIT. While we cannot guarantee results, we think this is a positive step forward to reduce the effects of rodents and mildew.

We also recommend that you purchase plastic containers that seal properly so that mice cannot get in. Use these to store boat covers, Bimini covers and any other fabric that can become a nest. It is a good practice to take life vests home. Please understand that Everett's Cove will only place covers in these containers. If you want to place Bimini or other items, you must do that prior to releasing the boat to Everett's Cove.
